

END OF YEAR AWARDS POLICY

POLICY GOALS

Hilton Primary School's End of Year Awards policy has been created in consultation with the School Board and staff. The aim of this policy is to ensure a consistent approach for the selection of student awards.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

School:

- Staff will collaborate and determine the allocation of awards using professional knowledge, data analysis and discretion.

DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS

Teachers will select students to receive awards for the categories below. As educators, academic growth and good scholarship are valued and will be rewarded.

Classroom Award Categories (Pre-primary – Year 6)

Endeavour Award Criteria - 1 student per class

- Consistently working to the best of their ability
- Consistent application across all learning areas
- Measurable academic growth

Citizenship Award Criteria - 1 student per class

- Communicating positively and constructively with others
- Displaying an enthusiastic attitude to others
- Displaying kindness, consideration and support to members of the school community
- To be eligible the student must receive 'Consistently' in the Attitude, Behavior and Effort criteria on their school report.

Kindergarten

All Kindergarten students will receive a certificate of attainment at their end of year concert.



Woodside Science Awards

This award is supplied by Woodside and is awarded to two students, preferably from year 6; but may go to Year 5.

Woodside Science Award Criteria

- Continuous application across the Science learning area
- Always works to the best of their ability in Science
- Consistent well-presented work
- Displays a cooperative and positive attitude during science classes

Other Awards

For the following Categories there will be 2 awards for each category.

(Year 1 - 3 Award and Year 4 - 6 Award)

Molly Wilson Sportsmanship Award Criteria

- To be eligible the athlete must exemplify the ideals of sportsmanship with fair play, teamwork, ethical behavior and integrity.

Arts Award Criteria

- Continuous application across the Visual Arts learning area.
- Work is completed to high standard and demonstrates excellent skills and technique.
- Displays a cooperative and positive attitude during Visual Art classes.

Italian Award Criteria

- Continuous application across the Languages learning area.
- Always works to the best of their ability in Italian
- Displays a cooperative and positive attitude during Language classes.

Music Award Criteria

- Continuous application across the Music learning area.
- Always works to the best of their ability in Music.
- Displays a cooperative and positive attitude during Music classes

Dux Criteria (Year 6 student - 1 Award)

- Consistent display of academic excellence across all learning areas.
