## **VOLUNTARY SCHOOL CONTRIBUTION AND CHARGES 2024**

The Hilton Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of contributions and charges for 2024. The schedule is broken into four sections and will allow families to calculate all costs relating to education that they may incur throughout the school year. This is a requirement of the School Education Act 1999 and will understandably be very useful in enabling families to budget for such an important area of their expenditure.

#### Section 1: VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

The total amount of **voluntary contributions** parents and carers are being asked to pay for children from years Kindy to Year 6 in 2024 is \$60.00, which is the maximum set in the School Education Regulations 2000 as itemised in the table below. A discounted maximum family charge, for 3 or more children, of \$150.00 will apply.

Money collected is used to resource the areas listed above. The quality of our teaching and learning programs are enhanced when each family makes a contribution to the cost of supplementing school funding.

The costs outlined are for the whole school year and represents approximately \$1.50 per week.

Students will only incur costs when they are involved in a particular activity. The amounts represent the **maximum** charged for scheduled activities in 2024.

It could be helpful to include them in calculating up-front costs, although the actual costs vary and have not been estimated in our calculations.
